The following two children were conferred with the above award on 29th August 2022 on the occasion of Observance of National Sports Day from the Hon'ble Chief Minister.

1. Sri Pratap Tarei, Village Tangi, Dist.-Khordha

While playing , Sri Pratap Tarei of Tangi village, 14 years of age, heard of somebody had fallen in the nearby deep well. Immediately he rushed to the spot & find that one 4 years child, the youngest son of Sri Loknath Sahu had fallen in to the well while playing with friends. Although people nearby were gathered near the well, but nobody had dare to enter the well to save the boy. Without a second delay, he jumped to the well and caught the boy in his arms and kept floating till the local Fire Brigade team rescued both the children from the well.

2. Ms. Subhashree Rout, Village Raghunathpur, Dist.-Khordha

During evening hour of Dated 13.10.2021 at about 5.30 PM, Shubhashree Rout, aged about 10 yrs saw that a little girl named Khusi was slipped to the deep water of the village pond at Raghunathpur while washing her feet after playing with friends. As it was lonely place and she found that nobody was present, jumped into the water to catch Khusi. She pulled Khusi to the stair of pond. Meanwhile the villagers nearby came to the spot on hearing the sought of Subhashree and thus she saved the life of the little child putting her life in danger.
